Course summary	This eLearning course introduces the Once-Only Technical System (OOTS) which lets EU public authorities securely exchange official documents and data at the request of citizens and businesses as part of cross-border administrative procedures. It also shows how the OOTS upgrades the services offered by the "Your Europe" Portal and explains how the Single Digital Gateway Regulation sets the legal basis for user-friendly public services across Europe. Moreover, the course provides context, background and definitions of the OOTS, with further sections examining the user journey, components and architecture, and elements to consider in its implementation to deliver cross-border public services. It also provides an overview of supporting tools and services and a knowledge test.
Target audience	The primary target audience is comprised of those who contribute to the implementation of the Single Digital Gateway Regulation and the Once-Only Technical System in their countries, such as: IT professionals in public administrations; implementers of cross-border digital public services; eGovernment project managers; those involved in developing, implementing, or managing eGovernment solutions; policymakers; stakeholders in standardisation processes within the EU.







Language	English (and others TBC)
Level	Intermediate: The course is addressed to those who are involved in the Digital Public Services design, implementation, delivery, and interoperability, and who have completed the Introductory Interoperability course and the European Interoperability Framework (EIF) course. It is also recommended to follow the courses for the Introduction to Core Vocabularies, the Introduction to the Core Public Service Vocabulary Application Profile (CPSV-AP), the course for Getting started with the Interoperability Test Bed, and the course for Interoperability Test Bed: Conformance testing for managers. The course is approximately 35 minutes and explains how the Once-Only Technical System moves forward cross border interoperability in the public sector across the EU. This course gives a real-life example of reusing interoperable solutions in various business fields.
